

CLUB BY LAWS

1. All members must be financial by payment of annual Membership fees and attend 3 monthly meetings which may include the Annual General Meeting and also 4 club outings or club activities.
2. Members who have vehicles on club registration (RTA restricted Heritage "H" plates) must be financial and adhere to Club By Laws.
3. Members who have club registration must keep a current log book which is also subject to inspection including at the annual inspection of the vehicle.
4. Members who have club registration must notify the Club Registrar of any intended trip which will exceed 10 km radius from home garage.
5. Modified vehicles can be on club registration as long as they meet the RTA standards and requirements including an Engineer's report.
6. As from 30th June 2004, all owners of vehicles including motor cycles applying for club registration for the first time, must present the vehicle to an RTA approved vehicle examiner to obtain a "blue slip" of compliance for original registrations.
7. Any vehicle which is already on RTA restricted Heritage (H) plates and where registration has expired for more than 3 months, will also require an RTA "blue slip."
8. Failure to comply with the Club By Laws could result in the loss of Club Registration and the right to RTA restricted registration benefits.
